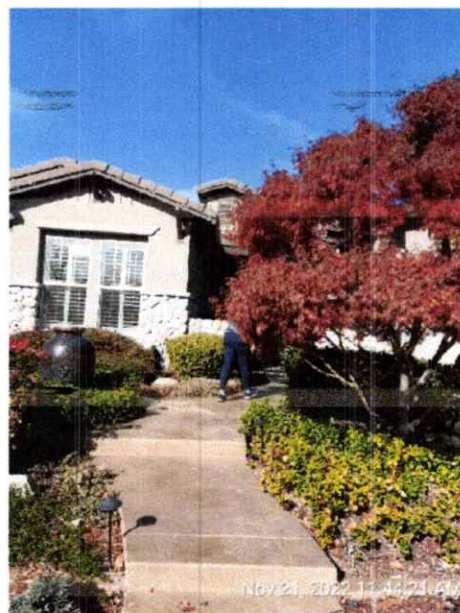
On 17 November 2022, Michael Walker, of Walker Confidential, formally retained my services to provide personal service of a Notice of Official Government Legal Proceeding, a Copyright Infringement Claim, and a Form to Opt Out of Copyright Claims Board Proceeding to be served upon Connor McKelvey at the current residential address of 3140 Black Oak Dr, Rocklin, CA 95765.

On 21 November 2022, at 11:40 AM, my partner, James Cordingley, and I traveled to 3140 Black Oak Dr, Rocklin, CA 95765 to attempt service upon Connor McKelvey. A red Ford pickup was in the driveway and a Toyota Corolla was parked on the street in front of the residence. There was an address sign attached to the front of the home which read "3140." I approached the front door with a package in hand and rang the doorbell. I observed movement inside and several dogs were barking inside near the door. A woman in her 60's with blonde hair approached me from the garage and said, "The dogs are not friendly." I told her I had a package for "Connor McKelvey." She said she'd take it and I handed her a manilla envelope containing the papers, which she accepted. When I told her they were legal papers for Connor, she suddenly said Connor

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
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didn't live there. I asked her why she was accepting his packages and she replied that she knew Connor but he didn't live there. When I asked her where Connor lived, she became very upset and threw the envelope at me. I picked it up, tossed it into the entryway, and turned to leave. The enraged woman picked up the envelope and hurled it at me as hard as she could, hitting me with it. I told her she wasn't allowed to do that but she said she could because I was on her property. I continued to walk away quickly, but she pursued me, picked up the envelope she had thrown and threw it at me again, this time landing at the very end of her driveway. Having witnessed the confrontation, James Cordingley, who had been waiting in the car, drove up and we left the area.
