ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On January 25, 2023, the claimant filed claim 23-CCB-0035 with the Copyright Claims Board (Board). On February 10, 2023, the Board found this claim compliant and filed a Notice of Compliance and Direction to Serve.

A claimant has 90 days after receiving the Notice of Compliance to file a proof of service or waiver of service form with the Board. 17 U.S.C. § 1506(g); 37 C.F.R. § 222.5(b)(3)(i); 37 C.F.R. § 222.5(c)(5).

The claimant filed a “Non-Service Confirmed – Respondent Sunlight Prod., Greentrees Films” on May 10, 2023. The proof of service stated that service was attempted at “854-A 5th Street, Santa Monica, CA 90403 on: April 28, 2023; May 02, 2023; May 05, 2023 and May 08, 2023.”

The claimant is ordered to show cause why this respondent, Sunlight Productions, Greentrees Films, should not be dismissed due to claimant’s failure to complete service on the respondent and file a valid proof of service within the 90-day period required under 17 U.S.C. § 1506(g). The claimant has until **June 8, 2023** to respond to this order. If the claimant does not respond to the order to show cause by that date, or if the claimant does respond and it is determined that service was not effective, the respondent noted above will be dismissed without prejudice—allowing the claimant to refile the case against this respondent before the Board or in federal court. In response, the claimant shall explain why this respondent should not be dismissed for failure to serve. 17 U.S.C. § 1506(v)(1). The claimant may, but is not required to, provide legal argument.

To submit the response, log into your eCCB account and take the following steps.

1. From your dashboard, you will see your claim under “Ongoing copyright proceedings.”
2. Click the “File in existing case” button and select this proceeding from the drop-down menu of active proceedings.
3. After selecting the correct proceeding, select “Response to Order to Show Cause” from the dropdown menu. You may type your response in the text box (there is a 10,000 character limit). You may also upload, as an attachment to that filing, any additional documentation you would like the Board to consider with your response.
